\_\_\_\_\_<sup>(2)</sup> and a long neck.

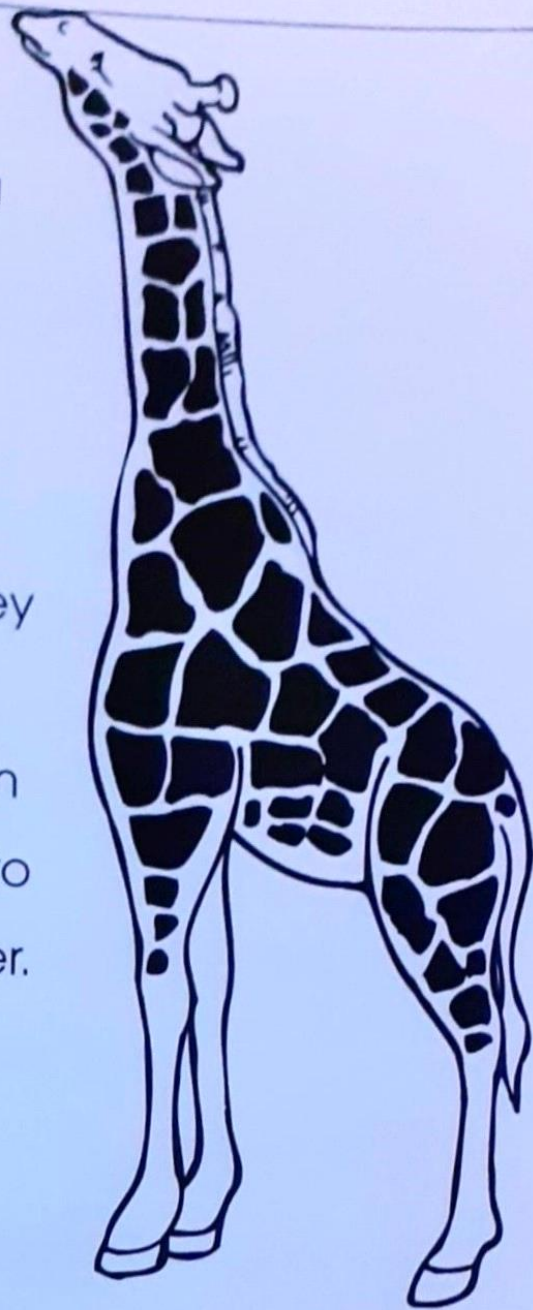
Giraffes live in the grasslands of
